NEW OPPORTUNITY TO SEE WORLD-FAMOUS PASSION PLAY

The world-famous Oberammergau Passion Play, held every ten years, was postponed this past summer because of the worldwide Covid-19 pandemic. Its once-everydecade performance has been rescheduled for 2022. Dr. Carlan Helgeson is hosting a ten-day tour to experience this dramatic portrayal of Jesus' life and death and to visit many European capital cities. The tour dates are June 29 through July 8, 2022. Cities to be visited include Munich, Innsbruck, Regensburg, Prague, Dresden, Leipzig and Berlin. Air travel to and from gateway cities, first-class lodging, two buffet meals per day, and transportation are all included as well as the hard-to-get Passion Play tickets.
