WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY, JANUARY 18-The global Church is invited to dedicate a week to pray for the unity of the Church. The theme for the week is "Abide in my love...you shall bear much fruit." (cf. John 15:1-17). We reminded ourselves about the importance of praying for the fruits of closer communion with our brothers and sisters in Christ and greater solidarity with the whole of creation. The traditional period in the northern hemisphere for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is January 18-25. Those dates were proposed by Servant of God, Fr. Paul Wattson, SA, founder of the Society of the Atonement, who initiated observance of the first "Church Unity Octave" in 1908, to cover the original days of the feast's of the Chair of St. Peter (Jan. 18) and the Conversion of St. Paul (Jan. 25), and, therefore, have a symbolic significance.
