UPCOMING COMMEMORATIONS

Erik, King of Sweden, martyr, died 1160. Tuesday, May 18, 2021 - Erik is considered the patron saint of Sweden. As king of that nation, he tried to bring peace in the region, and to spread Christianity in Scandinavia. He was also known for his attempts to make fair laws and to protect those who were poor or sick.

Helena, mother of Constantine, died around 330. Friday, May 21, 2021 - Influenced by her son to become Christian, Helena (or Helen) lived an exemplary life of faith. She is also remembered for traveling through Palestine building churches on the sites she believed to be associated with Christ's life.

PENTECOST SUNDAY, MAY 23 - During the 9:30AM service, we will celebrate the sacrament of Holy Baptism for Haylee Jayde Newsome, daughter of Christina and James. TRINITY SUNDAY – MAY 30, 2021. Christians remember and honor the eternal God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. We remember the Father as our Creator, the Son as our Savior and the Holy Spirit as our Comforter. While the word "trinity" does not appear in in Scripture, it is taught in *Matthew 28:18-20* and *2 Corinthians 13:14* along with many other Bible passages. The concept of the Holy Trinity can never be completely understood. That is the mystery. Understanding this comes through the work of the Holy Spirit; therefore, it is appropriate that this mystery is celebrated the first Sunday after Pentecost, when the outpouring of the Holy Spirit first occurred. In order to better understand Trinity Sunday, you must first know Pentecost Sunday and why it is celebrated.

MASK WEARING UPDATE

The CDC has issued new guidelines for mask-wearing. Fully vaccinated people don't need to wear masks outdoors anymore unless they are in gatherings with unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated people. The agency continues to recommend masks at indoor public places where the transmission is likely to occur. We will continue to wear our masks and keep a safe distance for our sitting arrangements in the church sanctuary. Small group indoor gatherings for meetings are still recommended to wear a mask unless all participants have been fully vaccinated and everybody agrees to remove the masks while still keeping safe distancing. We continue to encourage everyone to assume a caring nonjudgmental attitude, respecting everyone's sensitivity and comfort level.
