2024 TROMPETER GRANTS AWARDED: The Nativity Mission Endowment Committee has awarded Trompeter Fund grants to the following groups for 2024: Lighthouse for the Blind, NAMI, Crafty Ladies, Pastor's Discretionary Fund, Days for Girls, Team 6363, Dawn Center, Nativity Lutheran Food Pantry, Golden Rainbow Ranch, Homosassa Elementary School, Hernando Hope, Resurrection House, Holy Cross Food Pantry, People Helping People (Senior Blessings and Neighborhood Blessings), Blankets for the Homeless, Nativity Radio Ministry, and Crescent of Hernando. A total of \$57,820.00 was given out this year; the details of the awards are posted in the narthex and Administration building. The David and Dorothy Marie Trompeter Endowment Fund was established through a bequest from the estate of Dorothy Trompeter in 2008. No church operating expenses, building or maintenance projects, or mortgage payments are eligible for grants.
