



NICENE CREED

God has made us his people through our baptism into Christ. Living together in trust and hope, we confess our faith:

We believe in one God – the Father, the Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

Rejoicing that Jesus is risen and love has triumphed over fear, let us pray for the church, the world, and all those in need of good news.


After each petition: God of grace. Hear our prayer.





Let us pray the prayer Christ himself taught us:


THE LORD'S PRAYER
