US POSTAL FOOD DRIVE - SATURDAY, MAY 11. The annual United States Postal Food Drive is held across the nation. In Hernando County, boxes and bags of food are collected by mail carriers and brought to Forest Oaks Lutheran Church for processing. The food is then given to participating local pantries.

As a participating pantry, Nativity Lutheran Church needs to provide volunteers to assist that morning and early afternoon. We need to supply people in three ways:

- 1. Help to sort and box food at Forest Oaks Church.
- 2. Drive banana boxes full of food back to Nativity.
- 3. Help to sort the boxes that are delivered to Nativity.

We will need about 10 people to assist us on that Saturday. A sign up sheet will be posted in the narthex or you can reach out to Todd and Janet Holly (352-503-6215). Thanks for your help in advance.

PEW & CHOIR CHAIR UPHOLSTERY. We had a setback in our project to replace the upholstery on the pews and choir chairs. Our selected vendor (Walt's Upholstery) is not able to work on our project. We have therefore made the decision that we will need to delay the installation of the upholstery until we can select a new vendor for this project.

We identified three vendors that we thought would be qualified for this project. We are actively working with another of those vendors to do this work.

This new vendor has given us the option to either proceed with the fabric that we previously selected or to select other fabrics that they have used on pews and chairs for other churches. We hope to have samples of those other fabrics available for review by the congregation on Sunday April 21.

It is likely that the new vendor will need until late summer or early fall to order the fabric for this project. We will therefore proceed with the installation of the new carpeting in mid-May and then follow with the installation of the new upholstery later in the year. We are disappointed at this delay; but focused on
