Matthias, Apostle. Tuesday, May 14, 2024 - Matthias was the apostle added to the Twelve after Jesus' resurrection, as a replacement for the dead Judas Iscariot. He had traveled among the followers of Jesus throughout the Lord's ministry. Formerly February commemorated on 24, Matthias's celebration is moved to May 14 in agreement with most Western calendars. Erik. King of Sweden. martyr, died 1160. Saturday, May 18, 2024 - Erik is considered the patron saint of Sweden. As king of that nation, he tried to bring peace in the region, and to spread Christianity in Scandinavia. He was also known for his attempts to make fair laws and to protect those who were poor or sick.
