Renewed in God's everlasting grace, let us pray for the church, the world, and all creation.







THANKSGIVING AT THE TABLE

We give You thanks, Father, through Jesus Christ, your beloved Son, whom You sent in this end of the ages to save and redeem us and to proclaim to us your will.

Let us pray the prayer Christ himself taught us:


THE LORD'S PRAYER


